General Procedures

- 1 Membership is a prerequisite to avail of any Academy Facility including tuition, Academy groups, and any other facility as may be provided from time to time. CADA Performing Arts is a private facility. Members & Parents agree to abide by the decision of the Director.
- 2 Membership of the Academy is open to all, subject to application and successful interview, assessment of potential talent, and appointment as a member by the Director. Appointment to membership and withdrawal of membership is at the sole discretion of the Director.
- 3 Applicants commit themselves to a minimum period of one complete season on initial application and renewal. Fees are not transferable and will not be refunded.
- 4 New members: a registration fee of €_____ is payable to place name on enrolment list.
- 5 Members who cannot attend at their appointed times forfeit that particular lesson/session. Individual lessons which for unforeseen reasons have to be cancelled by the Academy will be made good. Members are obliged to phone the Academy at the earliest possible time if they can't attend class.
- 6 Members who are ill should not attend the Academy.
- 7 Respect for yourself, fellow students, teachers and property is required.
- 8 All members are responsible for their own personal property.
- 9 The Academy is a smoke free, chewing gum free, illegal substance free and, while in class, mobile phone free zone.
- 10 Members who are not achieving progress appropriate to their potential, or who display lack of commitment towards Academy work will forfeit membership.
- 11 Practical Examinations (LAMDA, ISTD or RAD) are mandatory and very strongly recommended by the Artistic Director. Examinations take place annually in May and June.
- 12 Members preparing for examinations are required to be very thorough in preparing their work to their highest possible standard. Members who are deemed not to have achieved a sufficiently high standard will not be allowed to sit their exam and will forfeit their exam fee.
- 13 All members attending outside auditions or performing in outside productions or entering festivals/feiseanna must notify the Academy before attending. Members who fail to do so will forfeit their membership.
- 14 The parents/guardian give permission for professional photographs/videos of the member in performance.
